

## **Louie Boji**

Louie Boji is the founder and managing member of the Boji Group. He earned a law degree in his homeland of Iraq from the University of Baghdad, June 1965. He immigrated to the United States in 1968 and became a citizen in 1974. Louie became involved in a number of grocery and party stores with a variety of partners. His role was to provide finance and management expertise. Ownership of most of these stores included real estate ownership. Another of Louie's roles was to manage and operate that real estate.

Louie has developed two retail centers. In 1987 he developed the 70,000 square foot Marysville Plaza, which included the location of one of his grocery stores. In 1992 he developed a 136,000 square foot retail center in Shelby Township, which has since been sold. In 1998 he sold his last store and since that time he has been primarily involved in the development, ownership and management of real estate with the Boji Group.

Louie's single largest accomplishment was coordinating the purchase of the Michigan National Tower from Michigan National Bank in 1998.
